5. Background

Due to heavy congestion on the roads and lack of integrated training to the drivers, a large number of road accidents take place in India every year. These accidents are fatal in certain cases and in other they leave a long-lasting disability on the victims. These accidents have a very serious impact on the economic and social lives of the affected families. The studies of various road accident carried out in the past concluded that most of road accident occurs due to driver's fault and are avoidable, if the drivers had undergone the proper training before getting the driving License.

Unlike India, other countries are very disciplined in their road safety regulations because they understand the importance of Education and learning on Safe Driving & road safety and have the provision for their drivers to have few hours of theoretical and practical **mandatory** training before applying for the Driving License.

However, in India, Due to the growing population, ever-increasing density of traffic on our roads, limited number of **Approved Driving Training Schools**, large and diversified population, it is really difficult to reach and educate people all around the country on the safe driving and road safety topics. In Punjab, there are apx 149 driving Schools authorized and approved by Punjab Government. Most of these Driving schools do not have the online infrastructure, knowhow and do not possess the technical manpower capacity to fulfil the online training provision as mandated by MORTH, GOI in the CMV (Sixth Amendment) rules dated 31/3/2021.

Based on the adequate provision in New Motor Vehicle Act Amendment 2019 which directly or indirectly focus on ensuring good driving skills and knowledge of rules of road regulation among the drivers, The State Government through Department of Transport, Punjab feels that there is an urgent need to create a robust training mechanism with more stringent monitoring and testing before issuing a Driving License and this can be achieved by adopting IT technology through virtual (online) Driving Training Schools to educate the youth and drivers on the road safety rules and regulations which can leads to safe and secure road experience.

To strengthen this motive, the department of Transport would like to adopt an alternative method whereby a driver education school is approved to teach all or part of the classroom

portion of a driver education course by an alternative method (online mode) of instruction (AMI) that does not require students to be present in a classroom that meets the following requirements.

The required online driving training solution includes testing and security measures that the department determines are at least as secure as the measures available in the usual classroom setting; the course satisfies any other requirement applicable to a course in which the classroom portion is taught to students in the usual classroom setting;

Through this online training solution any user can learn driving safety, current driving laws, defensive driving techniques, road safety rules and regulation, by using their mobile or computer.

This online platform (web and Mobile app) can provide all the knowledge and skills needed to become a safe driver. The entire training content should be interactive (audio, video, Animation) covering a wide range of training programs to suit the needs of every driver license seeker, from the complete beginner to the experienced driver.

The overall objective of this solution is to provide the all-necessary education and training to the new as well as experienced drivers who are either applying for a fresh license or renewal for a driving license. This Solution will be provided to all the Punjab Government Authorized Driving Training Schools for delivery of Online Training (Theory) on Course Content approved by the Government. This Solution can also be available for all the Traffic rules Offenders to re-learn the road safety rules and regulation.

6. Scope of Work

As mentioned above, the required Solution shall be a comprehensive web and Mobile App Solution covering in depth knowledge on various modules like Licensing, Road Signs, Safety on Roads, Rules of the Road, Behaviour on Road, In Case of A Crash, Good Samaritan Act etc (as per the course content defined in Road Safety Act) and should have following features:
