In pursuance of the provisions of Sub Rule (2)(d) of Rule 11 of the Central Motor Vehicles, Rules, 1989 Educational institutions/ colleges affiliated to Central/State Universities as well as Universities recognized by the Central/State Government, having strength not less than 500 students are authorized to issue a certificate to their students only with regard to the possession of adequate knowledge and understanding of the matters referred to in sub Rule(1) of Rule 11 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, for getting learners license from the concerned licensing authority under Rule 10 of the Rules ibid.

To authorize the educational institutions/ colleges recognized by the Universities as well as Universities affiliated to Central/ state Government as well as Universities recognized by Central/state Government for issuing certificate to their students only with regard to the possession of adequate knowledge and understanding of the matters referred to in sub Rule (1) of Rule 11 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989- guidelines thereof.

The state Govt. has authorised the Educational institutions/ colleges affiliated to Central/State Universities as well as Universities recognized by the Central/ State Government, having strength not less than 500 students to issue a certificate to their students only with regard to the possession of adequate knowledge and understanding of the matters referred to in sub Rule (1) of Rule 11 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, for getting learners license from the concerned licensing authority under Section 8 of the Motor Vehicles, Act, 1988 and Rule 10 of the Rules *ibid*. With a view to follow the procedure for the purpose , the following guidelines are to be adhered to:-

- 1) The provisions of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, Rule 11 of the Central Motor Vehicles, Rules, 1989, the Punjab Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 and instructions issued under the MV Act/Rules are to be followed meticulously .
While issuing certificate it may be assured that the applicant (student of their college) has acquire adequate knowledge and understanding with regard to the traffic sign, traffic signal and the Rules of the road regulation made under Section 118 of the Motor Vehicles, Act, 1988.
- 2) It may be assured that the student has the knowledge about the duties of a driver when his vehicle is involved in an accident as specified under Section 134 of the Motor Vehicles, Act, 1988, the precautions to be taken while passing an unmanned railway crossing and documents which are to be carried while driving a motor vehicle.
- 3) On having been passed the question of objective type by the student such as specified in Annexure VI of the Central Motor Vehicles, Rules, 1989, a certificate shall be issued for getting learners license
- 4)


from the licensing authority concerned subject to the provision of Section 4, 7 and 8 of the Motor Vehicles, Act, 1988.

5) Periodical statements shall be submitted to office of the District Transport Officers/Sub Divisional Magistrates (except Distt. H.Q) under intimation to the State Transport Commissioner, Punjab.

6) Any information sought by the Transport Department shall be supplied within the prescribed period.

7) In case of any irregularity and violation of the provisions of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, The Central Motor Vehicles, Rules, 1989 and the Punjab Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 and instructions issued under the Act/Rules, action under the law is liable to be taken.
