In pursuance of powers under Rule 108 of Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 and all other powers in this behalf, Governor of Punjab is pleased to allow beacon lights on vehicles, the use thereof, as detailed hereunder, superseding all previous notifications in this regard:

HIGH DIGNITARIES

1. Red Light with flasher (under Clause 1 (iii))

- His Excellency, the Governor of Punjab
- Chief Justice and Judges of Punjab and Haryana High Court

Note: 4 vehicles of General Administration (Protocol Branch) will be authorised use of Red Light as and when dignitaries from outside visit Punjab who have been authorised use of Red Light by Government of India or their respective states or Union Territories.

2. Blue light with flasher (under Clause 2)

- Escort Vehicles travelling with above mentioned dignitaries

(Clause 6) In case vehicle is not carrying the dignitary, or the dignitary is not on duty, red or blue light, as the case may be, light shall not be used and be covered by black cover.

EMERGENCY DUTY (vehicles with 'Ambulance', 'Disaster Recovery', 'Police' or 'Fire Services' as the case may be, painted prominently in 12" letters)

3. Blinking Red Light with Purple Glass (under Clause 1(iv))

- Ambulances (only while attending an emergency)

4. Amber Light with blinker (Clause 1(ii))


- Disaster/ Recovery Equipment.

5. Flashing Bar/Console (Red, Blue, White) (only when attending to an emergency) (under Clause 4)

- Police Vehicles
- Fire Service Vehicles

Subject to :

- 1) In categories 3,4,5 when vehicle is not on duty as mentioned above, the light shall be covered with a black cover.
- 2) Light shall be used only after sticker issued by Additional Director General of Police (Traffic), Punjab has been displayed on vehicle's windscreen.
- 3) Details of stickers i.e. sticker number, name of dignitary, vehicle number, category under which permission granted will be intimated by the ADGP to the State Transport Commissioner, Punjab, Chandigarh.
- 4) Above authorisations to use beacons atop front of vehicles are subject to notifications issued from time to time in this regard by Government of India.
